WALK THE GLOBAL WALK

Walk the Global Walk! is hitting the road over the next three years (2017 - 2020)!

The project, promoted by the Region of Tuscany and Oxfam Italia Intercultura and co-funded by the European Union, connects 11 European countries: Italy, France, Croatia, Cyprus, UK (Wales and Scotland), Portugal, Greece, Romania, Bulgaria, Bosnia and Herzegovina and Albania.

By providing teachers and students from middle and high school with the proper tools to include the topics and methods of Global Citizenship Education in the school curriculum, within schools and for schools' sake, in order to strengthen the partnership with Local authorities on the sustainable development issues. The core topics addressed are going to be:

- SUSTAINABLE CITIES AND COMMUNITIES (SDG11)
- CLIMATE ACTION (SDG 13)
- PEACE, JUSTICE AND STRONG INSTITUTIONS (SDG 16)
